NOTES and PAYMENTS

The easiest way to pay and complete permission notes is through School Bytes, which you can access through the website – make a payment button (or there is an app)

School Bytes allows you to give permission for events, make a payment and see payment history.

If you would like to part pay an event (eg camp)

- tick the event the default is for full payment
- go to the balance owing and type in the amount you wish to pay
- hit enter and the payment total will update

SCHOOL PICK UP - CAR PARK

Please ensure you are mindful of our little people in the car park.

Always hold their hand, park in the marked spots in the carpark and avoid parking on the crossing.

If you are parking along the fence, please leave a gap between your car and the fence so that students can walk down the fence line rather than negotiate the roadside.

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MACARTHUR REGION School Safety PROGRAM

Working together to improve road safety around our schools

Take extra care in our 40km/hr school zones. Your speed makes a difference!

The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for both pedestrians and vehicles outside our schools.

Most 40km/h school zones operate between 8am and 9.30am, and from 2.30pm until 4pm. The school zone speed limit must be observed during these times even if school children cannot be seen.

Reduced speed limits in school zones help protect our children, who are more vulnerable and can be unpredictable.

Did you know, if a young pedestrian is hit by a car driving 10km over the 40km/h school zone speed limit, they only have a 10% chance of survival! Every kilometre matters, the faster you go, the longer it takes to stop.



Fines and loss of demerit points apply if the 40km/h speed limit is not observed. For more information visit transport.nsw.gov.au **Remember, your driver behaviour can help keep everyone safe.**




Remember


